# Hazel Leininger July 22, 1922-January 12, 2017

Hazel was a member of the National Extension Homemakers Council and served in many positions in her Longmont Club and County Council and Colorado Extension Homemakers Council before serving as the Publicity Chair Relations Chair at the National level. She remained active when the organization changed its name in 1991 to the National Association for Family and Community Education! She was a friend and mentor to everyone she encountered. She also served as the editor of the national newsletter "NEHC Update" for 7 years. She was instrumental in the National Tree Planting Project in the early 1980's and was nominated for the 1981 Mrs. Lyndon B. Johnson Award for outstanding women volunteers for her leadership role in the NEHC Week's "Plant a Seed of Education" Program. She was a 4-H leader for 25 years, a Campfire Girl Leader for 5 years and served as a Den Mother for Boy Scouts. She was a trained lay judge for over 30 years for the 8 or more County Fairs each summer, and also judged sewing contests, "make it with wool" contests, and the Colorado State Fair Home Economics for 10 years. She served on the Board of Directors for Cooperative Extension Service, the 4H Council, The Women's Highway Traffic Safety Council, the Opportunity School in Longmont for Radio and Television. In 1998, Hazel served as the Crew Chief in her son's successful Land Speed Record attempt during the "50th Anniversary Bonneville Speed Week in Salt Flats, Utah and was interviewed by French television press as the 76 year old lady serving as the push driver and diagnosing car problems! Hazel also served as the volunteer activity director for Life Care Center in Longmont and was awarded the Best Volunteer Coordinator Award in 2000. Many in Colorado will remember Hazel for her KLMO radio show "HAPPY TALK HOUR!" which she hosted after her daughter's accident. Hazel received numerous awards and recognition for her volunteer and community service. She was loved by everyone who knew her and will be dearly missed. She moved to Oregon to be near her son after the flood in September 2013. Hazel is preceded in death by her daughter Marlene in 1971 and husband Henry in 2002. She is survived by her son Jim, his wife Jeanne, grandsons Matthew and Mark, and great grandson Henry.
