ACWW was founded to share the experiences of women in rural communities around the world. We hold Consultative Status with the United Nations and its agencies, giving us access to international systems and many governments. To be effective, we need to hear from our members about the realities of their lives.

Globally, the challenges facing rural women are often similar. Access to education, safe local transport, healthcare, or social protection systems like pensions, are a concern for every Rural Woman around the world.

We are committed to the Sustainable Development Goals and believe that greater representation of rural women is critical to their success.



ACWW invests in funding of grassroots development projects. These are designed in partnership with local women, many of whom are members of our global network. The projects are responsive to community needs, women-led, and informed by more than 40 years of experience with Rural communities. ACWW uses its knowledge and experience, combined with the extraordinary expertise of local women who know best what their communities need, to develop projects that lead to whole community transformation. We fund projects that address three priorities:

Climate-Smart Agriculture
Rural Women's Health

Education and Community Development

Since 1977, ACWW has invested more than £4.5 million in grassroots, women-led projects in rural areas.
