#### **Tuesday Events:**

#1. Ellis County Historical Churches Tour: 9:00 to 10:15 am. Bus will leave at 9:00 am. The early Volga German settlers in Ellis County held strong religious and family beliefs. They dedicated labor and materials to build their churches in the early 1900's. Outstanding Gothic styles with stonework, hand-carvings, & beautiful stained glass windows; each church is unique and interesting in its own way.

#2: Sternburg Museum Tour: 9:15-11:30 am. (\$10.00 admission fee) 3000 Sternburg Drive, Hays Bus will leave for the museum at 9:15 am. Sternberg Museum ranks among the best of natural history museums with real specimens from the Great Plains. The museum's collections include the finest assemblies of Pteranodon material complemented by excellent groupings of modern biological materials, remarkable mammals, reptiles, & plants.

#3: Medical Evolutions: 10:30 - 11:30 am. Presented at Hilton Convention Center. Denise Marcum will follow the trail medical practices and procedures have taken as space age discoveries take medicine forward into a new frontier.

### **Keynote Speakers:**

<u>Tuesday Evening Banquet:</u> 6:00 pm.: **Dr. LewAnn Schneider, DVM** will share stories, including videos, from her life as a USDA field veterinarian working with all creatures great and small!

Wednesday Morning Special Sessions:

8:00-9:00 am.: **Jeff Ochampaugh, President of Agrilead, Inc.** will share about new developments in seed care products, and expand upon the significant and impactful work Kansas agricultural innovators have been doing within our country and world. Jeff is a Rooks County native, KSU graduate, 35-year veteran of the crop protection industry.

9:00-10:00 am.: **Mari Baird Tetwiler**, is a native of northwest Kansas. She earned a Master's degree in education from KSU, taught K-12 gifted students, and was instrumental in implementing creative problem solving programs in Kansas schools. Besides writing her first book, Mari has founded a "Girls Seminar", where young girls can connect with and learn firsthand about career paths from women leaders across different career fields.

**Keynote Speakers, con't:** 

10:00-11:00 am.: Nicodemus, a small town in Graham County in NW Kansas, is the only remaining western town established by African Americans who, as freed slaves, were homesteading following the Civil War. Angela Bates, executive director of the Nicodemus Historical Society will share some of the highlights of the history of Nicodemus and update us on the recent documentary she directed, "Children of the Promised Land".

Wednesday Luncheon Speaker: Imagine traveling west with your family, hoping to make a new start, only to have your life turned completely upside down when your wagon is attacked by renegade Indians. **Bonnie Brewer** will recount the story of the family members who survived the ordeal and how their lives were changed from that point on. Bonnie is a native of Sabetha, and is a Family & Consumer Science Agent for Butler County Extension.
